Policy overview and purpose

- Complete the KPSC Swimmer Committee Nomination Form
- A Have your application seconded and signed by your coach
- Discuss your application with your parents/caregivers (if you are under 18 years old)

Upon receipt of your application, you will be notified via email if your application is selected to progress to an interview with representatives from Knox Grammar School, Pymble Ladies College, the Coaching team and KPSC Committee.

Successful applicants will hold the committee position for the current calendar year.

- Middle Years Swimmer Committee Position (Years 7-9) 1 selected applicant from Knox and 1 selected applicant from Pymble.
- Senior Swimmer Committee Position (Years 10, 11 and 12) 1 selected applicant from Knox and 1 selected applicant from Pymble.
- Alumni Swimmer Committee Position (Swimmers who have left school) 1 selected applicant from Knox and 1 selected applicant from Pymble.
